

# **ClimbHI Service Excellence Certificate** 2024-2025 School Year Recap

The ClimbHI Service Excellence Certificate, developed for the Hawaii Department of Education (DOE) Career and Technical Education (CTE) program, has reached 3,800 students statewide since it was launched in early 2020.

The Service Excellence Certificate helps graduates be more workforce ready. The curriculum was exclusively developed in partnership with the Nolan School of Hotel Administration at the SC Johnson College of Business at Cornell University, one of the leading hospitality administration programs in the world. Upon completion of the 9 module, on-demand training, students receive a Service Excellence Certificate of Achievement from Cornell University and ClimbHI. Courses cover skills development, managing customer interactions, and Aloha Spirit Law as outlined in the Hawaii Revised Statutes.

Over the 2024-2025 academic year, 801 participating students in grades 9-12 at 15 high schools statewide were sponsored through generous donations from 22 partners. Over the course of the last 5 years, over \$300k has been directed to this important workforce development credential. Mahalo to our 2024-2025 partners and schools for their generous support of this program.
