

The 2nd Annual HTA Work Wise Program, created and executed by ClimbHI, provides participants with in-person exposure to potential part-time or full-time jobs as well as career pathing available at the participating businesses. This year's program consisted of 8 different events across 4 islands with activities ranging from being a customer, job shadowing, mentorship, site visits, hearing from business leaders, as well as direct job placement. Participants received job application support to include but not limited to: resumes, completing applications, interviews, and much, much more. Businesses shared current job openings, benefits, career pathing, and provided expedited application processes.


